REQUIRED INFORMATION

 GOTSOCCER – Only participating players, including guest players and Club player pass players, must be entered into your team GotSoccer Event Roster. Photos must be included on GotSoccer. <u>Referees will use the GotSoccer App to verify each player prior to each game</u>. Only photographed players listed in GotSoccer can play. For instructions on downloading the GotSoccer App, please see the GotSoccer section of the tournament webpage.

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CERTIFIED ROSTER – Must have a copy of A or B uploaded to the event under the documents tab:

- a. <u>USYSA State Association signed roster</u> (NTSSA, OSA, STYSA, etc...) **All players** must be included. The roster must be signed by Registrar and Coach.
- b. <u>US Club Soccer Official Roster</u>. Each player must have a Card Valid date. If **NO CARD** is listed for a player then that player has not completed their US Club registration, and they are not eligible to play. If a player is registered on another US Club Soccer Official Roster, then we will need a completed US Club Soccer Player Loan Form for that player.

You MAY NOT mix USYSA and US Club documents. All rostered and Guest players must be from the same sanctioning body.

<u>Validated, laminated player cards</u> for all players must be taken to all games. (South Texas teams only)

- 2. **GUEST PLAYERS** If you are utilizing guest players or club player pass players, there is no limit to the number of guests you may bring, but your total player count cannot exceed the maximum listed in the rules for your age group. **Eligible Guest players must with documents uploaded into the documents tab:**
 - a. Be added as a guest in GotSoccer with a photo.
 - b. A copy of valid, laminated player card. A virtual card will not be accepted.
 - c. Provide a USYSA Guest Player Release Form with all fields completed (designated and provided by your state association).

OR

d. Provide a US Club Player Loan form with all fields completed (provided on US Club and U90C websites).

Note: All Guest Players need a release and a valid laminated player card. If you are unsure what document your State association requires, contact us.

- 3. SCORE CARDS Referees will have score cards for all games. At the end of the game the referees give the score card to the winning team (Home team in case of a tie) to be turned in at the tournament headquarters tent immediately after the game. To ensure your score is accurately reported make sure ALL information on the card is accurate before leaving the referee and the field.

 - b. Field number
 - c. Game time
 - d. Age group
 - e. Coaches have signed
